Reporting to the Chair of OB/GYN, the Vice Chair will lead the strategic vision while providing leadership for WMC Health Network OB/GYN program and work across the WMC Health system to promote a culture focused on clinical performance, patient satisfaction and program development while maintaining an active clinical practice and be eligible for an academic appointment with New York Medical College School of Medicine (NYMC) commensurate with experience.

The Vice Chair/Section Chief will provide direction and coordination of administrative, clinical, education, and research endeavors for the Department of OB/GYN inpatient services, the Institute for Women's Health and Wellness outpatient center, and the regional perinatal services. WMC, the system's 650-bed flagship hospital and Level I trauma center, has one of the highest case-mix indexes in the nation, caring for the most severely ill or injured patients in the country. WMC averages over 1,100 deliveries per year and has a 49-bed Level IV Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. The Vice Chair/Section Chief will expand volumes and quality through clinical service line strategy, growth, cost containment and improved efficiencies. The Vice Chair/Section will also serve as a mentor to faculty and help to enhance or develop further research endeavors.

WMC Health is a 1,700-bed healthcare system headquartered in Valhalla, New York, with 10 hospitals on eight campuses spanning 6,200 square miles of the Hudson Valley. WMC Health employs more than 12,000 people and has nearly 3,000 attending physicians. The Department of OB/GYN at NYMC is dedicated to undergraduate and graduate education and excellence in Women's Health Care. The department includes multiple clinical sites spanning the academic medical center and teaching hospitals for residency education programs.
