Assistant Dean, Medical Student Education

The Sanford School of Medicine (SSOM) seeks candidates for an Assistant Dean of Medical Student Education (www.usd.edu/med). SSOM is a community-based medical school with a tradition of excellence, and is highly ranked in family and rural medicine. SSOM is the 2017 recipient of the AAMC Spencer Foreman Award, considered by many to be the top award that a medical school can receive.

The Assistant Dean will work in the Office of Medical Education providing direction, guidance and oversight for the clinical training year (Pillar 2) and the Longitudinal Integrated Clerkships; collaborating with the Parry Center and clinical faculty to plan and design new instructional strategies using simulation and other methodologies; developing and implementing curriculum in emerging areas required to maintain accreditation and meet the educational objectives of the school.

This position will also chair the integration subcommittee of the medical education committee.

This position will represent the institution and its innovative curriculum at the national level. The successful candidate will have an M.D./D.O. with current SD Licensure or ability to obtain one and appropriate certification for field of specialty. The individual should have leadership experience in a medical school or similar environment. Experience in student services in an academic environment is preferable. The USD Sanford School of Medicine is committed to increase the diversity of the campus community. Candidates who can contribute to the climate of inclusivity are encouraged to identify their experience in these areas.

The Assistant Dean reports to the Dean of Medical Student Education and is expected to work effectively with colleagues through-out the medical school and with our clinical affiliates.
