Description

The Department of Obstetrics/Gynecology &Women's Health at Montefiore Medical Center, Albert Einstein College of Medicine has an immediate opening for the Division Director for Gynecologic Oncology. This key leadership role oversees the patient care, education and research programs within the division of nine full time medical staff, a well-respected ABOG accredited fellowship, and multiple scholarly and research clinical trials including collaborations within the NCI designated Cancer Center and the Department of Genetics.

The successful candidate must be NYS license eligible, board certified in Obstetrics and Gynecology as well as board certified by ABOG in the subspecialty of Gynecologic Oncology. S/he must have a national reputation of scholarly achievement and commitment to top scholarly participation in clinical research programs. Qualification for the level of Associate Professor or Professor in teaching or scholar track is required. S/he must have proven clinical and surgical skills in advanced gynecology and gynecologic surgery and knowledge, interest, and expertise in intensive and supportive care. Experience with supervision of physicians and clinical and administrative staff is critical and the ability to manage the division to yield outstanding patient outcomes and patient satisfaction is expected.
