Henry Ford Health System seeks an experienced Pulmonary and Critical Care physician with a proven track record of building/growth and leadership who can bring ideas and an identity of national prominence to the Division of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine. This candidate will work closely with clinicians, Department of Medicine Division Heads, and other Chairs and leaders within Henry Ford Medical Group and Henry Ford Health System to develop and implement best practices for inpatient and outpatient care with the intent of supporting the continued expansion and integration of Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine in a collaborative and fully integrated model when possible. In addition to providing vision to the clinical enterprise, this candidate will increase the research throughout the Division, building on the strengths and scope of the Division.

The Division of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine consists of over 40 faculty and 30 fellows at six (6) sites throughout southeast Michigan. These sites include multiple outpatient clinic sites and three (3) HFHS hospitals. The Division offers a full spectrum of tertiary and quaternary care services for complex lung disease and the most advanced therapies available for airway disease in the U.S. The Division serves as a major referral center and encompasses the largest intensive care unit complex in Michigan, with over 100 critical care beds (and growing). This is a very large Division with a distinguished history. In addition to strengths in pulmonary medicine and critical care, the Division has an ILD program that is growing, on target to hit 50 transplants this year. And given their presence and recognition in the region are a large referral center for pulmonary hypertension. These are areas that are ripe for world-class research.

Reporting directly to the Chair of the Department of Medicine, this candidate will provide oversight for applicable services within Henry Ford Medical Group. The Division Head will be a senior leader providing insight and guidance to the Henry Ford Health System (HFHS) in all five (5) of HFHS markets to ensure continuity and quality outcomes while pursuing growth opportunities for Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine services. Candidates for this position should have a strong academic track record and be prepared to build a strong research enterprise in areas such as clinical trials, quality improvement, translational medicine, precision medicine and population health. The Division Head is also responsible for advancing the medical education mission; ensuring a robust, innovative fellowship program; and developing an environment of scholarly inquiry.
