The University of New Mexico School of Medicine and the Department of Neurology is seeking a Child Neurologist to serve as the Division Director of Child Neurology. The successful candidate will be trained in Child Neurology and have a strong track record of administrative accomplishments and program building experience. Excellent clinical skills is a must as the incoming Director will be expected to participate in the clinical activities within the UNM Hospital Child Neurology Program which includes rounding on the Inpatient Teaching Ward Service, Consult Service, and Outpatient Clinic. Excellent communication skills, ability to work collaboratively in an interdisciplinary setting, and experience teaching house-staff and medical students are desired.

UNM Hospital is the premier tertiary care center for the State and the only Level 1 Trauma Center and Burn Center in all of New Mexico. The Department of Neurology has over 30 faculty and supports strong residency programs in Adult Neurology and Child Neurology, as well as established fellowship programs in Neurophysiology and Vascular. In addition, the Department of Neurosciences is particularly strong at the University of New Mexico, with a recently funded NIH Clinical and Translational Science Center and a state-of-the-art clinical and animal neuroimaging research facility. There are ample research and collaboration opportunities, both in basic science and clinical research.

The Division of Child Neurology currently includes faculty with general as well as specialty expertise in epilepsy, headaches, cerebral palsy, neuro-genetics, congenital vascular disorders, neuroimaging, and other developmental disabilities. The Division Director position is a newly created role. Leadership at the Hospital, University, and Department levels are all interested in supporting the continued growth and success of Child Neurology. We are seeking a leader who will build upon existing strengths in clinical, educational, and research efforts, while elevating the Division to national prominence with UNM being the premier destination for Child Neurology care in New Mexico and beyond.
