

Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) invites applications and nominations for the position of Executive Vice President & Dean, School of Medicine. Reporting to the President, the Dean provides the vision and leadership for the academic, research, clinical practice, community engagement, and fundraising activities for the School. They will guide a complex, high-functioning organization within a successful integrated health science enterprise to advance all of the School and University's missions. The Dean will play a key role in defining and implementing OHSU's mission and vision and in establishing and maintaining strategic institutional partnerships around the state and world-wide.

All clinical chairs, basic science chairs, and School of Medicine Center and Institute Directors report directly to the Dean and the Dean must enable their success and encourage interdisciplinary and translational activities. The Dean is also President and Board Chair of the OHSU Faculty Practice Plan (FPP) that currently has about 1,600 members including physicians, advanced nurse practitioners, physician assistants, and other licensed providers.

The successful candidate will possess an exemplary record of research, medical education, patient care, and community engagement. They must have substantial administrative experience and the capacity to exercise policy leadership at the local, state, national, and international level. They will have the proven ability to effectively work with faculty, staff, students, and alumni, and partner with the other deans and institutional leaders. The dean will bring a strong track record of assessing needs, developing and executing strategic plans, and engaging faculty, staff, and students in a vision. A medical degree is required.
