We will depart Bellevue and head north with our first rally point in Monroe.

From there, the group will travel the beautiful and renowned SR 2 through the Cascade Mountains to Leavenworth, the former logging town that was famously transformed into a charming Bavarian Alpine village. Participants will have time to stroll the town, enjoy the sights, and, of course, get their fill of bratwurst and other local favorites.

After lunch, the Pony Trail continues south on the curvy and scenic mountain roads toward Ellensburg. From there, we will head west over Interstate 90, making our final rally point at the summit of Snoqualmie, where we will gather for a group photo and take in the ski resort views before continuing on our journey.



This approximately 240-mile Pony Trail offers a wonderful mix of winding mountain highways, sweeping vistas, and memorable stops, making it a perfect opportunity to enjoy your Mustang and the camaraderie of fellow enthusiasts.

PONY TRAILS Safety Briefing

Welcome to the 2026 Mustangs Northwest Roundup Pony Trails! Our goal is to provide a safe, enjoyable drive while showcasing our Mustangs and sharing time with fellow enthusiasts. Please review the following guidelines before departure.

Driver Responsibilities

- Drivers are responsible for the safe operation of their vehicles at all times.
- Obey all traffic laws, speed limits, traffic signals, and law enforcement directions.
- Participation in Pony Trails is voluntary, and each driver assumes responsibility for their own actions and vehicle.

Before Departure

- Ensure your Mustang is fueled and in good mechanical condition.
- Check tire pressure, fluid levels, and lights.
- Bring your driver's license, proof of insurance, and registration.
- Program the destination into your navigation system before leaving.
- Have a full tank of fuel whenever possible.
- Review the provided Pony Trail maps, which include the route, waypoints, destination info and contact numbers. Keep a copy with you during the drive or download it to your mobile device.

Driving in a Group

- Maintain a safe following distance. Do not tailgate.
- Drive in a staggered formation only when conditions permit; otherwise, maintain a single file with adequate spacing.
- Keep pace with traffic. Do not exceed the speed limit to stay with the group.
- Avoid sudden lane changes or aggressive driving. Use turn signals well in advance.
- Do not block intersections or attempt to keep traffic from merging.
- If traffic lights or congestion separate the group, continue safely and rejoin at the next waypoint.

Navigation and Communication

- Use the provided maps and route information for navigation. They include planned routes, waypoints, destination addresses, and important contact information.
- Follow directions from the Pony Trail leader and sweep vehicle.
- If you become separated from the group, continue safely to the next scheduled using your map or GPS.
- Do not make unsafe maneuvers or exceed the speed limit to catch up with the group.
- Cell phone use while driving should be hands-free and in accordance with state laws.

Parking and Stops

- Enter parking areas slowly and watch for pedestrians.
- Follow parking attendants and event volunteers.
- Be courteous to other motorists and visitors.
- Leave enough space between vehicles to allow others to maneuver safely.

Weather and Road Conditions

- Drive according to road and weather conditions. Turn on headlights when visibility is reduced.
- Increase following distance in rain or heavy traffic.
- Be prepared for changing conditions and possible construction or traffic delays.

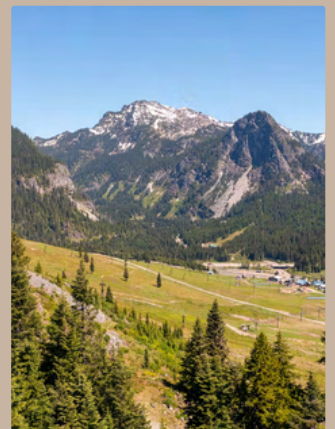
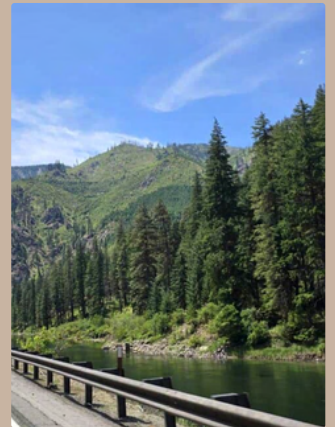
Emergency Procedures

- If you experience a mechanical problem, safely pull off the roadway and activate your hazards.
- Notify the trail leader or another participant if possible.
- In an emergency, call 911 first.
- Never stop in a travel lane or on a blind curve.

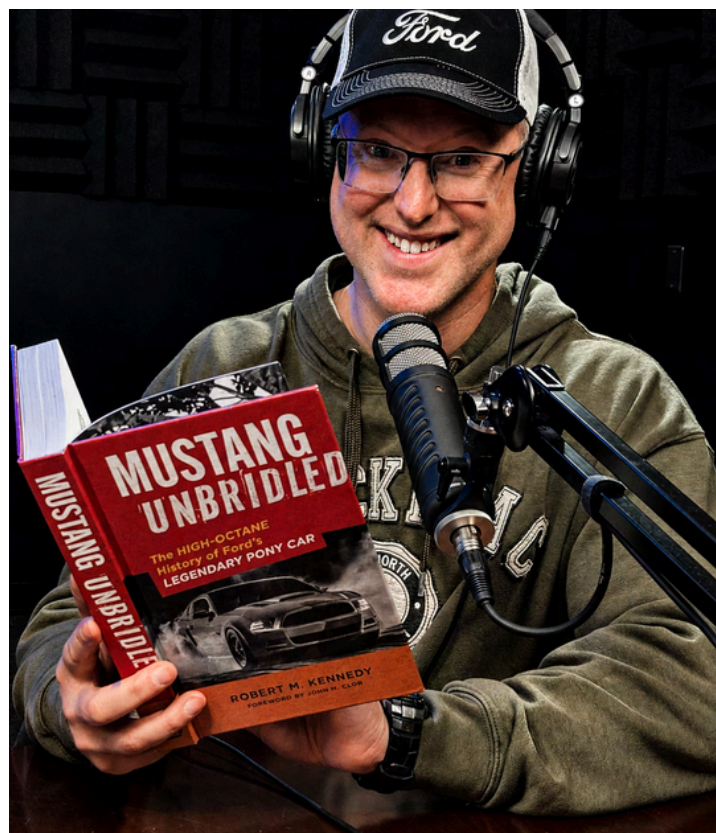

Red Lion Hotel Bellevue

The property highlights include free WiFi, a fitness center, a seasonal outdoor pool, pet-friendly rooms, and in-room conveniences like a microwave and refrigerator.

What's nearby for guests

The hotel is positioned well for event attendees who want quick access to downtown Bellevue dining and services. Red Lion Hotel Bellevue is close to Bellevue Square, Meydenbauer Convention Center, and other central Bellevue attractions, making it a practical base for guests during the July 16–19, 2026 event window.

Restaurant options near the hotel

For nearby dining:

- Solarium Kitchen & Bar is one of the nearest options and is listed about 0.1 miles from the hotel;
- Water Grill Bellevue is also nearby at 700 Bellevue Way NE
- Seastar Restaurant & Raw Bar is a well-known seafood option at 205 108th Ave NE, about 0.4 miles away.

Other nearby choices include:

- Bake's Place Bar & Bistro at 155 108th Ave NE (about 0.4 miles away)
- Daniel's Broiler at 10500 NE 8th St (about 0.8 miles away)
- Din Tai Fung in the Bellevue Collection area (about 0.8 miles away).

Other options nearby include: Mediterranean Kitchen, Nibbana Thai Cookery, John Howie Steak, and El Gaucho Bellevue approximately a mile from the hotel.

General Conduct

- Please follow the instructions of event staff, volunteers, and facility personnel at all times.
- Respect fellow participants, spectators, and the show venue.
- Aggressive, reckless, or unsafe behavior will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the event without refund.
- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Pets are welcome but must remain leashed and under control. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

Vehicle Movement

- Speed limit throughout the show grounds is 5 MPH.
- Yield to pedestrians at all times.
- No burnouts, rapid acceleration, excessive engine revving, or reckless driving.
- Vehicles may only be moved with the assistance and approval of event staff during show hours.
- Please use caution when entering or exiting parking spaces and display areas.
- Headlights should be turned on when moving vehicles through crowded areas.

Fire Safety

- Smoking is prohibited inside buildings and near fuel or vehicle display areas.
- Vehicles displaying fuel leaks or unsafe conditions may be required to leave the show field.
- Fire extinguishers are recommended and *required for participants in the MCA Judged Show*.
- Report any fire or emergency immediately to event staff.

Pedestrian Safety

- Watch for moving vehicles throughout the event.
- Use designated walkways whenever possible.
- Please keep chairs, coolers, and display items within your assigned space and out of traffic lanes.
- Be mindful of uneven surfaces and changing weather conditions.

Weather Preparedness
