### **Teen Leadership Weekend - March 28-30**

This one is pretty short notice, so I apologize. We have five 4-H'ers going to Camp Tecumseh in Brookston, IN for the first ever Teen Leadership Weekend March 28th-30th. I am in need of an adult volunteer who is willing to travel in a rental van or use their own vehicle and be reimbursed for mileage on the 28<sup>th</sup> to bring the five youth and Sthele to Camp Tecumseh. Then pick us up on March 30th. We'll leave from the fairgrounds on March 28<sup>th</sup> at 4:30pm EST. The trip is about 2.5 hours each way. If we use the rental van, the volunteer would then drive the van back. I need the same person or another individual to ride with us or bring us back on March 30th. We will leave Camp Tecumseh at 2:00pm on March 30th.

### **Spring Break at Vincennes University - April 7-9**

We are looking for adult volunteers who might be interested in spending spring break at Vincennes with approximately 40 Elkhart County 4-H'ers from April 7<sup>th</sup> to April 9th. We are using charter busses and leaving early Monday April 7<sup>th</sup> and will return via charter busses on Wednesday April 9th. This is a new unique opportunity for just Elkhart County 4-H'ers to experience life on a smaller college campus and learn about careers in health, science, engineering, aviation, surveying and precision manufacturing.

### **Elkhart County 4-H Camp Counselor Retreat - April 12-13**

We have a camp counselor retreat at Camp Amigo in Sturgis, MI from 9:30am Saturday, April 12th to 1:00pm Sunday, April 13th. I need two adult chaperones who are willing to stay the night and help our Elkhart County 4-H'ers get trained to be

camp counselors. Older counselors and Sthele will be leading most of the training. Meals and lodging are all provided!

### **Elkhart County 4-H Camp - June 2-6**

Elkhart County 4-H Camp takes place Monday, June 2nd through Friday, June 6<sup>th</sup> at Camp Amigo in Sturgis, MI. I also need several chaperones for this trip. All meals and lodging will be provided for this as well. I would love to have parents who are sending kids or volunteers that might be interested in taking a leadership role at camp for this. Sthele leads this activity and will send more details on exact times, planning meetings and schedule if you are interested.

### **4-H Round Up - June 23-25**

June 23rd to June 25th is 4-H Round Up at Purdue. This is a state trip to Purdue University where approximately 12-15 Elkhart County 4-H'ers will join over 500 other 4-H'ers from across the state and learn about college & career exploration. Adult volunteers stay in the dorms and eat in the dining halls on campus. You will stay with our kids a majority of the time. Sthele will be there to help as well. This will involve a lot of walking across campus. We need a couple chaperones for this as well.
