Dear 10th and 11th grade students and families,

On Wednesday, October 16th, all 10th & 11th graders will take the College Board PSAT/NMSQT test here at Baruch College Campus High School. The expectation is that all 10th & 11th graders sit for the exam, as it will provide great experience in standardized test taking and insight into the college testing process. Students should arrive at school by 8:15 am and will be assigned to a testing room.

This test measures reading, writing and language, and math, which are important for successful academic performance in college. It assesses your ability to reason with facts and concepts rather than the ability to recall and recite them. A high score can open the door to National Merit Scholarships, as well as bring you to the notice of many colleges and universities.

You must bring the following to the test:

- School identification card
- Your name, date of birth, address, current grade, and your school code which is 333803
- Pencils with erasers
- Scientific calculator

While the exam is free for the sophomores, there is a \$17.00 fee for all juniors. This is a fee that is charged by the Collegeboard. Please submit by September 23<sup>rd</sup>. There are fee waivers available. Please indicate at the bottom of this letter if you need to apply for a waiver. If you are able to help subsidize the fee for another student, that will be greatly appreciated. Please submit the money and the bottom of this form to either Janice or Ms. Hanna in room 304.
