















- According to the 2010 census, in Leon County there are more than 2,000 grandparent-headed families.
- 13.1% of all grandparents 60 years and older are responsible for raising their grandchildren.
- 39.8% of grand-families live below the poverty level.

- Siblings are more likely to be kept together.
- Family identity is preserved, encouraging a greater sense of self and security for grandchildren.
