Philly Families Read Together is an early literacy program that serves grandparents who are raising or caring for grandchildren, ages 3-8.

What We Offer

The 18-week **virtual** program encourages grandparents to be Literacy Champions. Participants build connections with one another while learning how to foster reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills in children. We focus on three themes:

Weeks 1-6: Literacy at Home

Weeks 7-12: Literacy at School

Weeks 13-18: Literacy in the Community
