The Sussex County affiliate of the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI Sussex) will offer one \$250 scholarship to a Sussex County Community College student with a mental health condition. The scholarship funds provided by NAMI Sussex shall not exceed a total of \$250 for the 2018-19 academic year.

Any student interested in applying for the scholarship should submit a letter to disabilitiessupport@sussex.edu, describing what helps them manage the symptoms of their mental health condition while pursuing their college education. Applicants' names will be known only to two SCCC staff members and one designated member of NAMI Sussex, who will serve as the review committee to select the recipient. The name of the applicant selected to receive the scholarship shall be shared additionally only with the NAMI Sussex treasurer, who will write a check to that student.

In appreciation for receiving the scholarship, NAMI Sussex requests only that the recipient visit the NAMI national website, www.nami.org, click Find Support, then click Teens & Young Adults, and from that page visit www.Ok2Talk.org.

Letters of application must be submitted via email (no hard copies) to disabilitiessupport@sussex.edu by 10/15/18. "NAMI Scholarship Application" must be included in the subject line of the email.

The recipient must be a currently attending Fall 2018 student at SCCC.
