**Prerequisite: Must have taken Digital Threat Assessment within 2 years of training date.**

Building upon the Digital Threat Assessment class by Safer Schools Together, Advanced Digital Threat Assessment advances participants' understanding of finding and curating relevant digital information consistent with real-life digital threat assessment data gathering scenarios. Significant engagement and hands-on practice will take place as participants are assembled into investigative teams and given a true-to-life mock scenario.

The final practical assignment will consist of working collaboratively as a team to navigate the realms of the social media world using all acquired DTA techniques to produce a digital baseline report using a template. Participants will receive templates and supplied standard operating procedures to leave with the confidence to independently establish a threat makers' digital baseline and produce a comprehensive report.

You will need to use a laptop, Macbook, Microsoft Surface or Google Chromebook to get the most from the hands-on portion of the training. Tablets are not compatible with some aspects of the training, and iPads have limited searching capabilities. Your computer will need to have firewalls disabled and unrestricted Wi-Fi access for this training. Please test your connectivity to a public network before attending.
