1. Learn and engage on a range of topics not covered in foundational training workshops. Topics may include, but not be limited to:
 - Enhancing Team Decision-Making and Effectiveness: Lessons Learned from Cognitive Science
 - Threat Assessment Interviewing: Considerations in Planning & Approach
 - Interpersonal Violence: Considerations for Assessment and Management
 - Violent Extremism & Terrorism: When Grievance Meets Ideology
2. Practice application of skills and lessons learned through small group work on case scenarios.
