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Most of Britain's bees are wild.

The UK is home to around 270 bee species, with more than 250 wild native species, including over 200 solitary bees that are vital pollinators of crops and wildflowers.

Heatwaves threaten the next generation.

Research has shown that just three days of extreme heat can leave male Red Mason bees infertile and reduce egg production in females by 15%, potentially leading to fewer bees the following year.

Wild bees are indispensable.

Many wild solitary bees are more effective pollinators than honey bees, making them essential for producing apples, cherries, oilseed rape and many other fruits and crops that support our food security.
