

## 4th Annual Native Pollinator Plant Sale!!!

Native plants are essential for pollinators and for the health of our ecosystems. Building on three years of successful sales with close to 4,000 native plants sold, Lexington Living Landscapes and the Lexington Conservation Office will again bring you Native Pollinator Plants for sale this spring. The sale will include a Sun Kit with plants that thrive in sun to partial sun and a Shade Kit with plants that prefer filtered light to shade. Each kit will include three plants of four different species for a total of twelve beautiful and healthy plants. The species offered this year are shown in the table below. In addition, we are also offering the six species of plants listed below the table "A la Carte" (sold as single plants).

Cardinal Flower ( <i>Lobelia cardinalis</i> ); (Summer)	Wild Columbine ( <i>Aquilegia canadensis</i> ); (Spring to Early Summer)
Slender Mountain Mint ( <i>Pycnanthemum tenuifolium</i> ); (Summer)	Wild Geranium ( <i>Geranium maculatum</i> ); (Spring to Summer)

### A la Carte Offerings (sold as single plants):



(1) Northern Blue Flag (*Iris versicolor*)



(2) Pink Tickseed (*Coreopsis rosea*)



(3) Foxglove Beardtongue (*Penstemon digitalis*)



(4) Woodbine (*Clematis virginiana*)



(5) Smooth Blue Aster (*Aster laevis*)



(6) Pennsylvania Sedge (*Carex pensylvanica*)

The plants are grown at a certified organic new england native perennial farm in New Hampshire and come in quart size biodegradable pots. The plant kits are sold at a highly discounted price of \$83 each, while the individual A la Carte plants are \$7.25 each. The sale opens online on Wednesday, March 13 for Lexington residents and on Wednesday, March 20 for non-residents. Payment is by credit card only. The plants will become available for pick-up on Saturday May 11 at the Lexington DPW, which is located at 201 Bedford Street. Any additional details will be announced as we get closer.
