lonely and full of hurt. We find healing in the Kingdom of God.

Jesus offers us a way to enter the gravitational field of God's Kingdom. Jesus counseled the rich, young ruler to "go, sell your possessions and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven." (Matthew 16:21). Jesus wants us to dismantle our world and join Him in a different one. Jesus offers us a way to use our money and possessions to set us free.

As my faith has grown, my attitude about money has changed. I still struggle with relying on my own self-sufficiency and trying to control my kingdom, but I am learning to focus not on being a collector of wealth and possessions, but to be a steward of God's Kingdom. The pull of financial


We offer two traditional services and one alternative service:


