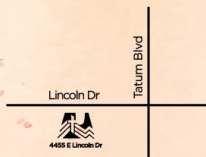


Dueling Divas: Americana

The Paradise Perk is open Sundays, 9 am-1 pm. Every purchase you make there supports youth missions and ministry.



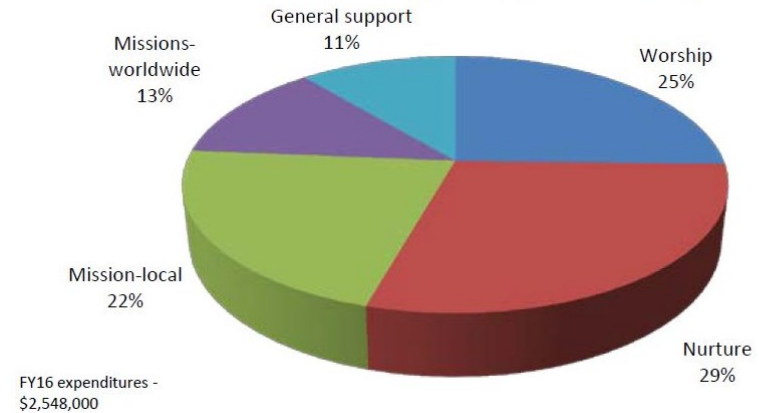
New Member Orientation

Frequently Asked Questions

Why should I give?

As Christians, we understand that everything we have comes from God. We give out of love and gratitude for God, and to support God's work through the church.

How much should I give? 10 percent?

The Bible teaches us giving in proportion to the material blessings we receive. We encourage committing a percentage of your income and increasing that percentage over time. Tithing means giving the first tenth or 10 percent of your income to God.

When should I give?

Regular, faithful giving cultivates a lifestyle of generosity and connects our generosity to our blessings. Pledge to give consistently — weekly, monthly, quarterly or annually.

Two Ways to Pledge

There are two ways to pledge your commitment to PVUMC: via our online form or via a pledge card. Both show your commitment to PVUMC, so choose just one.

Pledging 101: Two Ways

1) Online: Visit pvumc.org/pledge and fill out the online form as soon as possible. When you finish, you will have the option to set up automatic electronic payments.

2) Pledge Card: If you prefer, complete a pledge card and return it to the church office if you didn't turn it in on **March 5**. Please contact us if you have questions.
