

Bible Study for Busy Lives

For nearly 30 years, the original DISCIPLE Bible study has helped millions of people read through the Bible and grow their faith through a 34-week class. The new DISCIPLE FAST TRACK study leads groups through the Bible in 24 weeks—12 on the Old Testament and 12 on the New Testament. Study manuals and videos give participants tools to absorb and retain what they learn about the Bible. Our church is now forming a DISCIPLE FAST TRACK group to go through the study together.
