



RAFT (Refugee Assistance and Friendship Teams) welcomed the Abwe family on **May 22**. The new refugee family consists of single mom, Rebeka Abwe, and her four children, ages 19, 16, 15, 6. Originally from the Democratic Republic of Congo, the Abwes fled the Congo in 1999 and have been living as refugees in Tanzania ever since. They are Methodist. RAFT has again partnered with Lutheran Social Services. Thank you for making them feel welcome. Your time, treasure and prayers are needed as they adjust to their new life.


