How does the new lobby pickup service work?

On Tuesdays through Saturdays from 10:30 AM to 6:30 PM, patrons who have been notified that their holds are ready for pickup can collect them in the library's front lobby. For a step-by-step guide to reserving and retrieving holds, **click here**.

When will the library reopen?

The library remains closed until further notice. As we work with city officials to construct a safe and practical reopening plan, we will share updates through our <u>website</u>, <u>social media</u>, and email.

Will there still be a Summer Reading program?

What should I do with materials I currently have checked out?

All library materials that were checked out before the library's closure are due back on Friday, May 8th. Patrons can return materials in either of the library's two outdoor book drops. If you do not feel comfortable venturing out to return your books just yet, please call the library at (512) 259-5259 to speak with a staff member about getting an extension.
