The first step for those who need holiday help this year is to request it. Here's how:

Registration Dates: Oct. 19th-Dec. 1st. from 10:00am-5:00pm

Dec. 19th as a distribution date from 10:00am-2:00pm.

Documents required: gov't issued ID, birth certificate for each applying child; proof of SC (Jasper or Beaufort) residency, copy of current utility bill

Requirements to receive toys – Proof of residence (current utility bill with registrant's name on it), photo ID of parent and birth certificate for each child in the household.

Residents of Beaufort, Jasper and Hampton Counties may apply. Bluffton Self Help Registration will be held in a drive-thru format – behind Bluffton Self Help.

Mondays 3pm-6pm (Spanish Speaking Translators are available during this time frame ONLY)

Children Registration Ages Birth – 12 years old

Applicants must have: Photo ID, Current Utility bill or 2020 Government benefit award letter, Birth Certificate(s) for any child/children that did not receive toys in 2019, If legal guardian, bring proof of guardianship or custodial papers

Monday, October 26 through Friday, October 30 - 9:00 AM -12 noon & 1:00 PM - 4:30 PM and conducted at the Salvation Army office located at 2505 North Street in Beaufort. Date and time slots for the toy shop will be provided during registration.

Requirements to receive toys – Valid photo ID or ITIN card, proof of residence (lease or electric bill), Birth certificate for all children under the age of 12, DSS Benefits report is helpful, custody papers if raising grandchildren, nieces/nephews, or foster children. ALL current income from all sources: ALL current expenses.

*** All locations will be following the CDC's guidelines and practicing Social Distancing.**

All registrants, volunteers and employees will be required to wear masks at Registration Sites.

NO CHILDREN will be allowed at registration sites.
