Field Location:

PLAYERS WHO PLAY THE 8AM GAME, NEED TO BE AT THE FIELD AT 7AM

after each game on the main field, we will have fun games & contests - prizes to winners

BEFORE YOUR DAUGHTER COMES TO THE FIELD.....

- She should arrive 1 hour before her game time - report to her coach
- Parents - please make sure your daughter does not have jewelry on
 - no long nails allowed - they must be cut short
 - no pockets on her shorts or pants
 - make sure she has sneakers or cleats

you may want your daughter to wear leggings and long sleeve shirt, because we have 2 artificial turs, and 1 grass field. If you fall on the artificial turf, it burns.

- give her money to buy food at the concession stand - the prices will be Cheap!
- we will have sandwiches, breakfast, chinese food, pizza, etc
 - bring a sweatshirt, wind breaker - in case weather changes
 - we play in the rain (and the snow)
- we ask the girls to keep their phones at the information table - so they don't lose their phone

Saturday Girls Night Out - For flag football Girls ages 8 - 11 yrs. (please no siblings or friends)

The HTA Train will come pick up the first group of girls (upper keys first) at the Wicker Field Parking Lot

1st group - 4:30 leave - 6:30 return

2nd group - 5:30 leave - 7:30 return

Girls are dropped off at Front St. & duval - will then walk to Angelina's Pizzeria for 1 slice of pizza

If anyone wants soda, or a 2nd slice of pizza they have to pay for it.

Then the girls will walk to Key Lime Co. for free ice cream

The first group returns to Front St & Duval for pick up at 6PM

The 2nd group returns to Front St & Duval for pick up at 7PM
