



RE: Temporary Beer & Wine Package Licenses

The City of Canton is immediately suspending Canton Municipal Code Section 6-148(a) which prohibits a consumption on premises licensee from selling packaged beer and/or wine. This suspension is through April 30, 2020 and allows for restaurants to sell un-opened/un-corked bottles of beer or wine in package form with to-go orders of food. The licensee is still responsible for assuring that the purchaser is of age. Packaged sales of liquor are not allowed.
