Budget & Finance Committee

Association is sound. We have a line item allocated for reserves for the replacement of our major assets and operating expenses. We have a mortgage on our building with an interest rate of 4.5%, that interest rate is one of the main reasons we have not paid the building off. We have not had a dues increase since the late 90's and at that time it was just a \$1.00 to go from \$179 to \$180.

Annually, the Association has an audit by an independent CPA, we are happy to report we have received a clean audit report again for 2024.

Multiple Listing Service "MLS"

- This committee is composed of 13 active Realtors® and they have a full agenda every month. From reviewing the rules for compliance issues, to ensuring that our MLS data is accurate and easily accessible for our members. The MLS is your daily business tool and access to accurate listing information is critical.
- Data Compliance: to date there have been 1,659 agent reported violations submitted and reviewed by the MLS staff -
 - > 914 not valid
 - ▶ 564 processed
 - 181 duplicate reports

Coast 2 Coast MLS Data Share


Goal: Remove arbitrary boundaries to MLS Data which creates inefficiencies and instead facilitate a healthy marketplace which empowers Participants and Subscribers to better serve their clients.

- In 2024 we launched the Coast 2 Coast Data Share with Daytona Beach, Jacksonville, St Augustine/St Johns County, and Hernando County. The new collaborative endeavor allows more than 20K members access to listings from all four platforms within your native MLS system. By keeping our REALTOR® members central to the real estate transaction, this data sharing effort improves decision-making and enhances customer service, contributing to more successful real estate experiences for all involved. We are continuing data share conversations with other MLSs in the state.
- ► The Board of Managers meet once a quarter to review the MLS database for enhancements, alignment of the RESO Data Dictionary, and Data Share growth.

Realtor Political Action Committee

Each year, our RPAC goal is determined by a "fair share" formula based on our REALTOR® membership. For 2025, our goal is \$144,460, with 32 Major Investors and 37% member participation.

To date the RPAC Report is:

- > \$139,098 raised 96% of our monetary goal
- 14 Major Investors
- 29.35% member participation
- To close out the year, we're hosting a series of RPAC Socials across the county. These events brought together elected officials and REALTOR® members to discuss local issues, share updates, and network. Professionalism Pillar:

Grievance and Professional Standards

- In 2025, our Grievance and Professional Standards Committees continued to uphold the highest level of professionalism in the real estate industry. This year, 19 complaints were filed, resulting in 6 hearings addressing potential Ethics Violations and/or Arbitration disputes.
- Each complaint is first reviewed by the Grievance Committee. When a hearing is warranted, the case is referred to the Professional Standards Committee, which convenes a tribunal to ensure a fair and impartial process.
- New in 2025, the Grievance and Professional Standards Committee, in collaboration with the Professionalism and MLS Committees, hosted a Mock Hearing Day. This interactive event gave members a unique, first-hand look at the entire process—from the initial filing of a complaint to the final decision—as well as insight into how MLS fine disputes are handled.




Professionalism Pillar:
