1946 Chinese War Brides Act – H.R. 4844

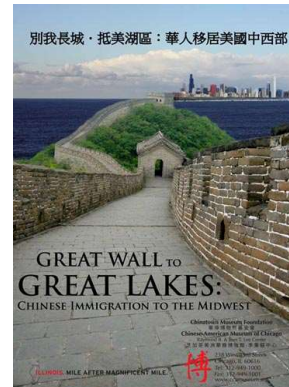
The Museum is excited to host a new temporary exhibition, *1946 Chinese War Brides Act – H.R. 4844*, a collaboration with the Chinese American Citizens Alliance (美州同源會) – Chicago Chapter. We thank the Chinese American Citizens Alliance – National Lodge for its generous loan.

Come see the document and pen used by President Harry S. Truman to sign H.R. 4844 into law, a significant piece of legislation that helped create a newly structured family system and stabilized the Chinese American communities.

Chinese Immigration to the Midwest

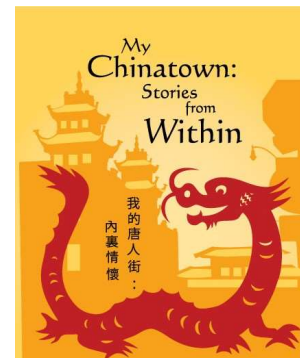
