





Q5 What is your affiliation with UCI?



Q6 What do you most like about your rental home?



Q7 What do you least like about your rental home?



Q8 How pleased are you with the care and maintenance of the exterior of your apartment community?







Q15 How well do you know your neighbors?









Q21 Based on your experience, is University Hills a welcoming community?


