

# RECYCLING GUIDELINES

## Plastic Recycling

Plastic recycling includes all RINSED plastic bottles that contain the numbers #1 thru #5 and #7: These primarily include soft drink bottles, milk jugs and detergent bottles. Check the bottom of the container. If you see the recycling symbol with a #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 7 in the center, it is acceptable.

## Metal Recycling

Metal recycling includes aluminum cans, tin food cans and clean aluminum foil. Remove all lids and insure that all items are CLEAN OF FOOD.

## Cardboard Recycling

Cardboard recycling includes corrugated boxes, paper tubes, cereal boxes (and the like), file folders, and poster board. All boxes MUST BE FLATTENED for proper disposal.

## Paper Recycling

Paper recycling includes newspapers, inserts, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, manila folders, computer paper and wrapping paper.

## Glass Recycling

Glass recycling includes juice, soda and water bottles; beer and wine bottles; and food jars. Lids must be removed from the containers and separated before being placed inside the recycling bin. All liquid and food waste must be removed before the item may be recycled. Do not break glass.

## Do Not Recycle

Do not recycle styrofoam, window glass and mirrors, waxed paper products, fabrics, wood, electronic waste (TVs and computers), motor oil containers, yard waste or food waste.
