

RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE GUIDELINES

Effective 8/1/20

5' x 5' x 10' Limit

Yard waste is limited to 1 pile per pick-up and that pile may not exceed 5' high x 5' wide x 10' in length. In addition, limbs cannot be larger than 5 inches in diameter. Please note that limbs and piles of yard waste exceeding these size requirements will not be collected.

Placement of Yard Waste

Yard waste should be placed near the street, but not in the roadway or in a location that obstructs the view of motorists. Yard waste should not be placed near fire hydrants, water meters, sewer drains, guide wires, utility poles, mailboxes, etc.

Vacant Lots

Yard waste generated from vacant lots or placed on vacant lots will not be collected. Only lots with residential structures are billed and eligible for this service.

2 Per Month Pick Up Schedule

Yard waste will be picked up twice a month beginning on Mondays. See below, for the complete schedule for 2020.

Commercial and Private Contractor Yard Waste

The residential yard waste program is designed to collect the day-to-day accumulation of yard waste. Landscaping debris generated by commercial and private contractors will not be collected.

No Mixing With Other Garbage

Yard waste may not be mixed with any other garbage (furniture, appliances, carpet, trash, boards, plastic, etc.)
