Call for Artists

2019 Edmonds Arts Festival Gallery Artists Father's Day Weekend, June 14-16

The 62nd Annual Edmonds Arts Festival is one of the longest running in the Northwest, attracting artists from across the nation. Profits from the Edmonds Arts Festival are returned to the community through the Edmonds Arts Festival Foundation. Programs include art scholarships, educational grants, public art installations, and ArtWorks, a gathering place for artists in downtown Edmonds.

MORE THAN \$10,000 IN CASH AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED TO GALLERY ARTISTS THIS YEAR.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE

Entry will be valid once payment is received by the Edmonds Arts Festival.

FEES & ENTRY INFORMATION

Artists can only apply to one category per CaFÉ profile. If you wish to apply to multiple categories, you must create multiple CaFÉ profiles. Profiles are free in CaFÉ.

You may **register** and sign-up as a new user to create a new profile with new login credentials. You can use the same name and email, but will need to alter your username and password. Keep in mind you will have two profiles to keep track of for this call.

Entry Fee: \$20.00 for each piece entered in Paintings, Prints, Drawings, Photography, Computer Arts and Three-Dimensional. You may enter up to 4 pieces per category.

Media Fee = fee for each additional entry in Paintings, Prints, Drawings, Photography, Computer Arts, Three- Dimensional

Entry Fee Miniatures: \$18.00 total for one to four pieces entered in Miniatures and Small Paintings. Use Coupon Code MINIS and IMAGES to correct pricing in CaFÉ. CaFÉ will charge \$20 per image entered. For example, if you enter 4 images to the Miniatures and Small Paintings category, the total will show \$80.

In order to correct the price, enter the following COUPON CODES:

- MINIS** for the 1st image (deducts \$2.00)
- IMAGES** for the 2nd - 4th images (deducts 100%)

Total will be \$18 after entering the above COUPON CODES.

GUIDELINES

- Artists must be 16 years or older.
- All entries must be for sale.
- 35% commission will be collected on all sales.
- All entries must be original and entirely the work of the artist.
- No copies, derivatives or reproductions; work cannot be based on copyrighted or previously published materials.
- Entries must have been produced within the last five years.
- Work must not have been previously shown at the Edmonds Arts Festival.
- Artists may not substitute or alter the work, title, or price after it has been accepted.

- Awards are chosen by the Jurors from the original works of art.
- Digital images of selected work will be retained by the Edmonds Arts Festival. EAF assumes permission to reproduce accepted artwork for promotional uses.
- Artwork not sold during Festival **MUST** be picked up at the Frances Anderson Center on June 16, 5:15 pm – 8:00 pm or June 17, 10:00 am – 1:00 pm.
Storage of unsold items for future pick up is not available. Therefore, if you cannot pick up your work, you will need to make arrangements for someone else to do so. Work remaining after 1:00 pm June 17 will become the property of the Edmonds Arts Festival.

TERMS OF ENTRY

Please be advised that every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition and return of your artwork. The Edmonds Arts Festival and its volunteers do not assume responsibility for loss or damage that may be incurred during this process. All work needs to be of a substantial enough nature to withstand these procedures. We encourage artists to carry their own insurance.

The Edmonds Arts Festival reserves the right to refuse any piece of unacceptable quality or any piece that does not match the image submitted, or does not meet the framing/finishing criteria. Final selections of all entries will be at the jurors' discretion.

CATEGORIES

Paintings: Oil, acrylic, tempera, airbrush, gouache, encaustic, batik, fresco, watercolor, collage and mixed media with painting dominant.

Prints: Relief, intaglio, mezzotint, lithograph, serigraph, monoprint, and mixed media with printmaking dominant. This does not include photographic prints.

Drawings: Graphite, pastel, colored pencil, pastel, silverpoint, chalk, crayon, pen & ink, conté and mixed media with drawing dominant.

Photography: An image from a single point of view, that originates from a camera. As long as the image is from a single point of view, post-processing edits are allowed such as color manipulation, high dynamic range, panorama stitching, element removal and filters.

Computer Art: Graphic art or digital imagery that may be generated from a camera and/or computer and may include computer graphics, generative art, computer illustration, and mixed media with computer art dominant.

Presentation and size requirements for Paintings, Prints, Drawings, Photography and Computer Art:

- Finished artwork must not exceed 44" H x 54" W. Framed pieces must fall within these specifications.
- Artwork must be wired for hanging. Saw-tooth picture hangers are not accepted. Hanging wire may be visible ONLY if it is part of the overall design of the piece.

Three Dimensional Art: This category encompasses both fine artisan work based on functional concepts and non-functional three-dimensional art. Included, but not limited to are: clay, mosaic, metal, stone, wood, glass, fiber, quilts, and jewelry.

Presentation and size requirements for Three-Dimensional Art:

- Three-dimensional work may not exceed 80" x 30" x 30".
- No on-site assembly is allowed.
- Textile entries must not exceed 2600 square inches.
- Hanging textiles, rugs or quilts must have a sleeve for mounting. A hanging rod must be provided. Nothing over 5 lbs. can be hung.
- Nothing can be hung from ceiling or overhead.

Miniatures and Small Paintings:

Entries in this category include all media under painting, prints and drawing categories. Photography is not accepted. This year, we are also accepting work which has less emphasis on fine detail and the 1/6 scale; however, the same size requirements apply. Miniatures follow DIGITAL IMAGE REQUIREMENTS (see below).

Even though the application process requires you to submit digital image(s) of your piece(s), the miniature and small paintings category is **not** juried from the online images, **only** from the original work of art. Artwork needs to be dropped off at one of the two locations below on or before April 2.

Presentation & size requirements for Miniatures and Small Paintings:

Your frame and artwork may be any proportion that meets the following criteria: Artwork can be any size up to 5" x 5" (25 sq. in.). This includes unframed gallery wrapped canvases with finished sides. Framed artwork must not exceed 8" x 6" (48 sq. in.), while maintaining the surface size of the artwork as noted above. *All artwork, framed and unframed, must be professional in appearance, wired and ready for hanging.*

Schedule for Miniatures and Small Paintings Category:

- **April 1** – online application deadline.
- **April 2** – deadline to **drop off** original artwork at one of the two galleries listed below. If artwork is not at the gallery by this date, it will not be considered for jury selection.
- **May 13-17** – notification of jury selection by email.
- **June 16-17** – pick up of non-selected and unsold pieces.

Please include a copy of the printed entry form from your online application with your artwork, and be sure it is wrapped and protected for drop off.

DIGITAL IMAGE REQUIREMENTS – ALL CATEGORIES

- Digital images are required for entry
- Paintings, prints, drawings, photography, computer art: one image per artwork
- Miniatures: one entry = up to four unique works of art (one image per artwork)
- Three-Dimensional: three views are allowed per piece but must be combined into one image

File format: JPEG only

File dimensions: minimum of 1200 pixels on the longest side

File resolution: 72ppi/dpi (standard web resolution)

Maximum file size: 3 MB (Files exceeding this size will be rejected)

Minimum file size: 100 KB
