

You Make Me Happy Card

Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Rainbow of Happiness (157721)
- Cardstock: Basic White (159276), Bermuda Bay (131197); Polished Pink (155710)
- Designer Series Paper: Sunshine & Rainbows 6" x 6" DSP (158126)
- Ink: Bermuda Bay (147096), Polished Pink (155712)
- Tools & Accessories: Brilliant Rainbow Dies (157726); Layering Circles Dies (151770), Sweet Hearts Dies (157623); Wink of Stella (141897), Mini Glue Dots (103683); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Paper Trimmer (152392); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Bermuda Bay (5-1/2" x 8-1/2")
- Cardstock #2: Basic White (3-7/8" x 5-1/8"); 2-3/4" circle (need 2)
- Cardstock #3: Polished Pink (scrap for heart)
- Designer Paper: 1-1/4" x 3-3/4" (need one of each color); one rainbow trimmed from DSP

Instructions:

- Score Bermuda Bay cardstock at 4-1/4"; fold to create card base.
- Adhere DSP strips to Basic White panel with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere layered panel to card base with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- Brush Wink of Stella over the rainbow cut from DSP. Set aside to dry completely.
- Use Layering Circles Dies to cut two 2-3/4" circles from Basic White cardstock.
- Use Brilliant Rainbow Dies to die cut a rainbow from the top half of one of the circles.
- Stamp sentiment under the die cut rainbow with Bermuda Bay ink. Stamp hearts with Polished Pink ink.

- Adhere DSP rainbow behind the negative of the die cut rainbow. Adhere the remaining die cut circle to the back. Adhere the layered circles to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Die cut a small heart from Polished Pink using the Sweet Hearts Dies. Adhere to the rainbow as shown with a Mini Glue Dot.
