Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamp Set: Hey Birthday Chick (154464)
- Ink: Bermuda Bay (147096), Pool Party (147107), Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

- Cardstock: Basic White (159276), Fresh Freesia (155613), Petal Pink (146985), Pool Party (122924)
- Designer Paper: Friendly Hello (159990)
- Accessories: 1-1/2" Metallic Mesh Ribbon (153550), Iridescent Rhinestone Basic Jewels (158130), Wink of Stella (141897)
- Stampin' Blends Markers: Fresh Freesia Combo Pack (155518), Petal Pink Combo Pack (154893), Pool Party Combo Pack (154894), So Saffron Combo Pack (154905), Color Lifter (144608)
- Tools: Birthday Chick Dies (158200), Layering Circles Dies (151770), Stitched Stars Dies (150653); Blending Brushes (153611), Bone Folder (102300), Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)
- Miscellaneous: Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Tear & Tape (154031), Mini Glue Dots (103683), (hole punch)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. For box bottom: Cut Pool Party cardstock to 6-1/4" x 10-1/4". Score on each side at 1-11/16" (scant 1-3/4"). Add 1/2" tabs to each of the short sides (see diagram.) Remove corners. Fold along all score lines and adhere sides together with Tear & Tape.



2. For slider: Cut DSP to 6-3/4" x 10". On long side, score at 1-3/4", 4-3/4", 6-1/2" and 9-1/2". On short side, score at 1-3/4". On the long side, use scissors to cut up to the 1-3/4" score line. Fold along all score lines and adhere sides and bottom with Tear & Tape.

3. Punch a small circle/hole in the center of the two wider sides of the DSP slider. Insert a 28" piece of ribbon through both holes. Put marshmallow peeps in box bottom, then slide the box into the DSP slider, pushing the ribbon down into the slider. Tie ribbon into a bow on the end of the box and trim ends.

4. To embellish DSP slider: Cut two stars from DSP using Stitched Stars Dies. Cut two banners from Fresh Freesia cardstock and two from Pool Party cardstock. Adhere stars and banners to top of slider with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

5. Die cut a circle from Basic White cardstock. Apply Pool Party ink to center with a Blending Brush. Stamp sentiment with Bermuda Bay ink. Adhere circle to slider with Stampin' Dimensionals.

6. Stamp chick on a scrap of Basic White cardstock with Memento ink. Color with Stampin' Blends Markers. Add Wink of Stella to head and tail feather, frosting and candle flame. Adhere to circle with Stampin' Dimensionals.

7. Add three iridescent jewels to the stars as shown.

8. To open, pull on the bow (do not untie.) The box will slide fully open to remove the treat!
