

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Medical Humanities – Future Interdisciplinarity 30th August - 1th September 2023

This workshop, arranged by the Centre for Medical Humanities and Bioethics (CMHB) and funded by Riksbankens Jubileumsfond, seeks to bring together researchers with a shared interest in the medical humanities, clinical medicine and/or biomedical research. We see medical humanities as embracing several perspectives within the humanities and the social sciences. The aim of the workshop is to explore the epistemological underpinnings of such interdisciplinary health research, addressing challenges and new directions that such interdisciplinary work faces. We invite contributions which broadly relate to this theme. Topics include, but are not limited to:

- Combinations of theoretical perspectives from the medical humanities and clinical medicine and/or biomedical research, with an emphasis on what such combinations entail.
- Possibilities and challenges that arise when combining methods common in the medical humanities or clinical medicine and/or biomedical research.
- Innovative combinations of theories and methods in the field of interdisciplinary medical humanities.
