The BCWF's Wetlandkeeper Course is a 2.5-day workshop about wetland conservation. Participants gain skills in wetland classification, site survey and health assessment, plant and animal identification, soil sampling, and hands-on wetland stewardship techniques.

Participants will receive a **BCWF Wetlandkeeper Certificate** and get practical experience stewarding local wetlands with ERA's ongoing projects at the West Fernie & McDougall Wetlands in Fernie, the Sparwood Beaver Wetland, and helping to construct a wetland at an abandoned gravel pit north of Hosmer.
