# Scout on the sea



On land and on sea, the Boy Scouts are always prepared. Locally, the scouts were able to test their water maneuverability thanks to some assistance from the Port of Beaumont.

April 27, Three Rivers Council-Boy Scouts and the Port of Beaumont announced the launch of Sea Scout Ship 1916 at the Sail Daze event in Port Arthur. The event provided approximately 100 attendees with a weekend of sailing, camping and a chance to learn more about scouting's second oldest program, Sea Scouts. Ships from Sam Houston Area Council, Alamo Council and Bay Area Council also took part in the launch.

"The Port of Beaumont is looking forward to chartering the new unit in an effort to bring awareness to the opportunities that exist in the maritime industry," Port Director Chris Fisher said. "We hope to act as a resource to the students who participate and show them how important maritime-related activities are to our region."

To ensure the program's success, Fisher will be joined by skipper Richard Evans, first mate Tonya Tomplait, committee chair Steven Meek, Port repre-

sentative Sade Chick and committee member Randal Ogrydziak. Together, the crew hopes to grow the program, which is open to all Beaumont Independent School District high school students. Students will take lead roles in the Sea Scouts organization, as adults serve in mentor positions to assist in the scouts' endeavors. Elected youth leaders plan and conduct the program and adult leaders guide and support their efforts as they learn leadership and life skills. As the shipmates gain experience, they will have the opportunity to contribute to the growth of the program.

Sea Scouting is designed to promote better citizenship and improved boating skills through instruction and practice in water safety; outdoor, social and service experiences; and knowledge of maritime heritage. Scouts are recognized and rewarded as they learn different maritime-related skills such as SCUBA, boating safety and CPR.
