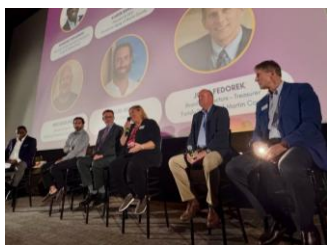
Community Connections
