On one hand, this has been a very difficult year: there was the shooting at the Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh and another in Poway outside of San Diego and there was the loss of a few members of our community who were influential in making us who we are.

However, there were some good moments from this year, too. The outpouring of community support we received after the Tree of Life shooting not only filled our sanctuary but our hearts with comfort. We have begun building bridges within the larger Savannah community, not only ensuring support for ourselves but being there for others in their times of need. Our new Homestyle Judaism class explored different topics and furthered the education of our community. We have launched new programs, new classes, and tried new ideas, all of which have helped us become a better community.

While we have our own ideas for how to continue to improve, we also value your input. As we reflect this summer and begin planning for the coming year, we want to hear from you: what do you want to see from our community? What would you like to know more about? How can we help provide you with the community you need? We want to create the best AA community for you, but cannot do it without knowing what that looks like for you. And while we likely can not accommodate every request, your input will provide us with ideas, themes, and thoughts to help our planning.
