SHALOM SCHOOL Eva Locker I am beginning this letter by paraphrasing our strategic plan: Congregation Agudath Achim Is Savannah's strong, vibrant, multi generational home of conservative Judaism. It is an egalitarian congregation that provides a spiritual, educational, and social community. It is welcoming and family oriented with meaningful Jewish learning and it is full with simcha. What a wonderful way to describe who and what we are! The past two years, with strong support by our Board of Directors, we have been alive with spirit in our synagogue, and as a congregation it has functioned very well. Sure we have problems, but we are making tremendous strides in overcoming them.

I would like to highlight some of the important things we have worked on very diligently. We started with an inservice process to develop a three-five year plan for the synagogue. Approximately 19 people participated in the development of such a plan. We have been trying very hard to ensure it is a major focus of our work. Following that plan, we have achieved much during these two fascinating years, all of which are a tribute to our financial, spiritual, and educational facets of synagogue life.

After much dialogue with newcomers to the Board, many of our members are first time Board participants. Prior to our first Board meeting, we had a retreat where all Board members came together to focus on the tasks in front of us. It was well received by the group and put all of us on the same page. We rented the rabbi's parsonage for approximately eight months and used the rent money to subsidize the cost of remodeling the synagogue-owned house. The rest of the money was paid from the building fund as was promised.

We revamped the process used for the Rabbi search committee ending with the successful hiring of our desired choice and his family. During the Rabbi search, we contracted with our Executive Director, Motti Locker, to be our spiritual leader during the search process and rewarded him with a well-earned bonus, and we were greatly served.

The offices were renovated and updated completely with money secured from the building fund account as was promised.

Our representatives on the Shalom School Board helped stabilize the Board's functioning and the educational achievement at Shalom School has since flourished.

Many more volunteers both young and old have been recruited into participating not only by their attendance at events, but also in the planning and preparation for such.

We established two new committees which are working very diligently to tell our story: public relations and marketing.

We revitalized the membership committee which recently began functioning again to better assure our congregants that each and every one is important to the synagogue.

In the last two years we have had four major fundraisers in addition to the Yom Kippur pledge. These events have brought much needed money into AA.

All private funds are now securely within the endowment of AA, the last two recently secured.

We organized and completed a wonderful trip to Israel with 25 people attending, enjoying pretty much everything there was to offer.

Last, but certainly not least, we secured private funding for the complete renovation and remodeling of the Karp Chapel. It is my hope and my goal to have the congregational meeting June 10 in this re-designed room.

Fellow congregants, we still have issues, but I have been so fortunate to have played my role in the success of the last two years. I want to thank the Board for actively supporting me on so many major issues. I also want to thank everyone who said to me during the course of my presidency "Thanks for all you are doing." That to me is reward enough. I began this letter paraphrasing an important message, and I will end it similarly: It takes a village to build a successful congregation!

I wish the future Board nothing but the best. Success is becoming to all of us.

FROM THE DESK OF THE RABBI

This July will mark my first anniversary here at Congregation Agudath Achim. During that time, we've had the opportunity to pray together, sing together, learn together, celebrate together, mourn together, and laugh together. I've enjoyed meeting and getting to know a lot of you through happenings at the synagogue, at my weekly Rabbi on the Road series at coffee shops around the area, at meals, and at community events. Those of you I still have yet to meet, I sincerely hope to have the chance to get to know you more in the coming weeks and months.

While I have made an effort to jump in, I have also made an effort to spend much of the past year becoming acquainted with Savannah, the Jewish community here, and the AA to see where our opportunities are. Here have been a few of my observations so far:

- One of the things I loved about AA since my initial interviews was the family atmosphere. Not only the presence and involvement of families, but the love our members have for each other and desire to do things together. We are as much a family as a community.
- We have a lot of members who not only want to make Judaism part of their lives, they have a strong desire to learn more on how to do so. They want more than a Jewish identity, they want their Judaism to be meaningful for how they live their lives.
- Our members are extremely active in the larger community, in both Jewish and secular interests. This activity
 demonstrates the love and caring our people have for Savannah and, in many cases, serves as an expression of
 their Jewish identity.

With some of these observations in mind, here are some of the ideas in development for the coming year:

- We want to foster this family atmosphere and develop it; let's continue to do things together, continue to spend time together, and continue to find ways to meet each other and develop those relationships which are so vital to our congregation. If you have ideas, my Rabbi on the Road series, where I go to coffee shops around town, will continue in August after a summer hiatus; stop by and share your thoughts!
- We are looking to expand our educational offerings. If you've ever wanted to learn to lead any of our services or to read Torah and/or Haftarah, classes will be offered to help you learn how to do so. If you just want to deepen your Jewish knowledge, we'll be offering a new series of classes, Homestyle Judaism, which will be coming to people's homes in different areas of town to talk about Jewish subjects. Come to an already established class, come to one of these new classes, or let me know if there are other subjects you'd like to learn; let us continue learning together!
- We, too, want to get involved in the larger community. While we have a close relationship with the JEA and Federation, we'll be looking to expand our community involvement.

All of these observations and ideas have one thing in common: you. Our community is wonderful and strong because of you and these ideas were created with you in mind. Now, we just need you to participate. We hope you'll stop by, have coffee, chat, come pray, come learn, or find other ways to be present. We are here for you and will continue to strive to make this the best community for you.

Thank you all for a wonderful first year and I look forward to continuing to grow with you in the coming year.
