STEM Scholarship: High School Seniors, College or Graduate Students who work at a local Darien business or branch of a larger company in Darien and is a Darien Chamber of Commerce Member in good standing or has a current member of their family working for a Darien Chamber of Commerce Member in good standing (parent, step-parent, aunt, uncle, sibling, grandparent, spouse, current employee) may apply for the Annual DCC Scholarship. (Not open to DCC staff/family.) Applicant must plan to major in STEM, an acronym for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math education.

There will be a \$1,500 scholarship awarded.

Applications must be postmarked no later than April 15th, 2019.

The chosen recipient of the scholarship will be announced in May & **the recipient is expected to ride in the Darien Memorial Day Parade** with the Chamber of Commerce Group. It is a requirement of acceptance that the scholarship recipient be available to ride in the Parade on Memorial Day.
