Delegate Count

The Bylaws of the League of Women Voters of Illinois makes the following provision:

- a. The convention shall be composed of the following voting delegates:
 - 1) One delegate representing each local League and each MAL unit for each 25 voting members or major fraction thereof based on the official membership roster which is used by LWVUS to determine per-member payment.
 - 2) A president or designated delegate from each local League and each MAL unit.
 - 3) The members of the board of directors of the LWVIL.

Based on that criteria, here is a list of delegates by league. Note that the membership numbers for your local league are based on the census data your league sent to LWVUS by the January 31st deadline.

Good news: membership in Illinois grew by 400 between February 1, 2016 and January 31, 2017. Congratulations!
