

FUNDING SOURCE MATCH ASSESMENT

<u>Instructions</u>: Assign a numerical rating between 1 and 4 for each category. For open-ended questions, choose 4 for "highly aligned", 3 for "predominantly aligned", 2 for "somewhat aligned" and 1 for "not aligned." For yes-no questions, choose 4 for "yes" and 1 for "no." Once you have completed each category, tally the total score and divide by 13.

CATEGORY	QUESTION	SCORE
Mission Fit	How does your mission align with the funding source's mission?	
Demographics	Does the population you serve of interest to the funder?	
Geography	Does the funder have an interest in the geographic area you serve?	
Funding Type	Does the funder offer the type of funding (e.g., program/project funding, operating funding, capital project funding? you are seeking?	
Eligibility	Does your organization meet the funder's eligibility requirements?	
Deadline	Are you able to meet the funder's deadline?	
Funding Amount	Do your funding needs match with the funders range of grant dollars awarded?	
Relationship	Do you have any connections with the funder? For example, one of your board	
Connections	or staff members knows one of their board or staff members.	
Collaboration Requirements	If the funder requires partner organizations/collaboration, do you have those? (Skip this question if the funder does not require collaboration).	
Reporting	Are you able to satisfy any funder reporting requirements?	
Requirements	(Skip this question if the funder does not require reporting).	
Past Awards	Has the funder awarded grants to other agencies and programs that your organization or programs/projects have similarities?	
Open to New	Is the funder open to funding new organizations? Hint: review past 990s to see if	
Agencies	they are funding the same organizations every year.	
Matching	Are any matching funds or is cost sharing required, and if so, are you able to	
Funds	meet those requirements?	
	(Skip this question if the funder does not require matching funds or cost sharing).	

Total Score:	Divide total by 13 for average score of:
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Ranking Key

- 4- A **high priority** funder: apply!
- 3- A **medium priority** funder: Consider applying depending upon the amount of time the application will take you in relation to the amount of funding the funder typically awards.
- 2- A **low priority**: not likely to fund your organization but may want to check back annually to see if anything has changed.
- 1-Not a priority: with little in common with your organization, this funder is unlikely to fund you.
