I. BIBLICAL / THEOLOGICAL FOUNDATION

A. “Love Your Neighbor as Yourself!”

II. DISCERNING OUR STEPS FORWARD!

2. What’s the Current Level of Illness in the Twin Cities and MN?

Throughout this process we will reassess and listen to updated COVID illness levels.

B. Vital Issues--

1. Levels of Comfort

If you’re not comfortable gathering with others at this time, we respect and honor that decision. We believe that choosing to stay home to protect yourself or a loved one is a sign of love, not a sign of fear or lack of faith. Our leadership wants to affirm those who choose to express “love of neighbor” in this way.

2. We’re all in a “Risk Group!”

While certain health conditions and generational cohorts are at “higher risk” for COVID, no one has immunity. Therefore, everyone in the population has some degree of risk.

3. Bless and Engage with Online Attenders

We will continue to offer “Crosstown Online” on an ongoing basis. We will acknowledge those who are participating online and include them as fully as possible.

III. WHAT’S OUR PLAN?

A. Phase 1: no public use of Crosstown building

B. Phase 2: June 15, Groups of <=10 in Commons, 1st floor only

C. Phase 3: Starting Sunday, August 2

The building will be open to Groups of ≤ 25 in the Commons & Large Gatherings in Sanctuary up to 125

Sunday worship will begin in person. Online worship will continue be available but in a different format.

1. Criterion:

- a. Events must be planned by Crosstown Commissions, staff, or Verbo en Accion
- b. Full Adherence to "Rules of Engagement" noted below
- c. Group Leader must be trained on building protocols (COVID Plan Admin / Video)
- d. Leaders will ensure that group follows all procedures when meeting and keep a record of attendance with contact information for each attender.

2. Approval:

- a. Groups of ≤ 25 submitted to Crosstown Office for approval in [google forms](#)
- b. Groups of > 25 must be submitted on the [google form](#) but will need to be approved by the "Reopen Team." Please give 3 days for your event to be reviewed.

IV. SPECIFIC PROTOCOLS for PHASES

A. Phase 3: Rules of Engagement

1. "Love One Another!" by Wearing a Mask!
2. Persons at "High Risk" per CDC guidelines are to Stay at Home
3. Persons with any illness or having a family member with illness are to Stay at Home
4. Wash Your Hands! Hand-Sanitizing Stations at both Entry Ways
5. Practice Physical Distancing of 6' at all times
6. No Physical Contact: including hand-shaking or hugs
7. No Food or Beverages served

B. Phase 3: Protocols for Worship Gatherings

1. Attendance Record: Please RSVP for the service (this process is still being finalized).
We will keep a record of those present in case we need to contact those persons.
2. Arrival / Departures: Persons are to arrive at the building with the persons they plan to sit with. Each group will be ushered in and out of the building and systematically seated in every other pew.
3. No Children's Ministry (Nursery, Galilee Gang) will be provided at this time.
We will provide specific initiatives to involve children in the service. Infants and children need to stay with their caregivers at all times.
4. Platform Personnel are to wear masks. The only exception is a single vocalist or single speaker who is a minimum distance of 12' from others.
5. Items / Practices that will be Absent: Printed Bulletins, Congregational Singing, Offering Plates (offering to be deposited in boxes near Sanctuary doors), Refreshment Time in Commons, and Education Hour
6. Communion: We will use pre-filled cups with the wafer included (The Miracle Meal)
7. Post Worship: The Commons will be closed. Connecting with each other needs to occur outside the building while staying aware of physical distancing.
