Industry Interviews

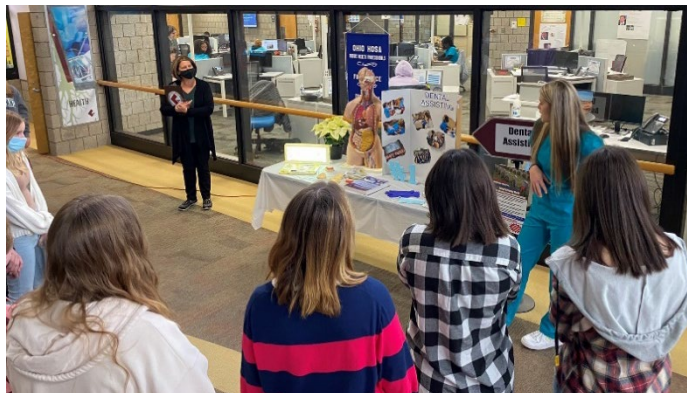
On Friday, November 19, CVCC students did a great job with the Industry Interview Event, when they interviewed professionals in their chosen field. 90 students interviewed with 48 businesses of which 22 were located in our associate school district communities. The goal of the Industry Interview project is to broaden student knowledge of current hiring practices and trends in their program area. The following nine programs participated: Architectural Mechanical Design, Auto Body Repair & Refinishing, Construction Trades, Digital Design, Electrical Systems, Graphic Imaging Technology, Media Arts, Power Equipment Technology, and Programming & Software Development. Many successful and well-known businesses and organizations participated including Action Door, Angstrom Graphics, Brecksville School Bus Garage, Cleveland Browns, Cleveland Metroparks, Cuyahoga Valley National Park, First Energy, MCPc, Progressive, Sohar's All Season Mower Service Inc., Towlift Inc., and Village Auto Body. Due to remote work, a few students interviewed business representatives in their classrooms, and two businesses participated virtually. Most

reviews of our students during the experience were outstanding! Thanks to all who put in time and effort to make the event a success; especially Elizabeth Martin our new Job Placement Administrative Assistant and Martha Sluka, CVCC's Career & Community Resources Specialist. Additionally, thank you to Maria Dworning, current Administrative Assistant to the Assistant Principals and former Job Placement Administrative Assistant who contributed to the event through helping train Elizabeth; Sandra Leach, Administrative Assistant, Data & Accountability, who developed the systems for the event over the past decade and shared her knowledge, as well as assisted in taking class photos for the event, and Gabrielle Scorzino, Media Specialist who also took class photos for the event. SkillsUSA Leadership Conference

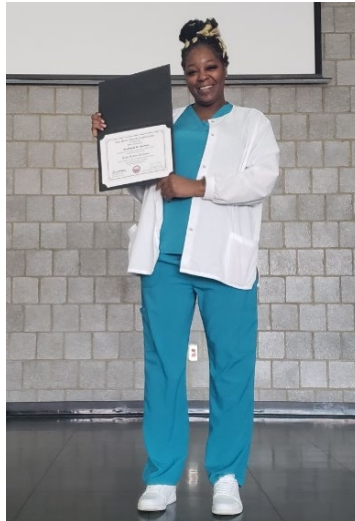
