Phone only instructions

If you **only** have a phone, you can still participate by dialing **one of the numbers in the invitation** and when asked to, **enter the Meeting ID**. Using a phone to connect limits your participation to sound only; without seeing the other participants, instructions or demonstrations shared via computer screens. **I strongly urge you to make use of the video link either by smartphone or laptop with a camera.**

Once you have joined the webinar there are some **etiquette items to be aware of**.

1. First is that it is technically possible for everyone to speak at once. But that is not the way to run a meeting with 20, maybe someday 200 people. All talking at once. All with wives in the background, dogs, grandkids, TV's and music making a huge "din" of background noise.

So- the Host (or coordinator) will mute everyone. This is NOT to control or limit anyone. The host and the presenter will be the only two not muted to start.

2. Speaking #1: To manage the background noise, the host – usually me (Coordinator), will place everyone on mute. The presenter will deliver his opening presentation and then there will be a question and answer period.

If you are on a phone only, and not a smart phone or computer, when no one is speaking just say "I have a question please" and you will be called on in turn. Please wait until called.
