## FAQS

## Frequently Asked Questions

1. *What are the sleeping arrangements?* We will be in a property with bunk-bed style housing: men/boys together, women/girls together.
2. *Are credit cards accepted/how much cash do I need?* Credit cards are accepted in larger stores. ATM is available at the luggage section of SJO airport. Personal spending cash amount is a personal decision, but best to have bill denominations of \$20 and less
3. *Can I drink the water?* We will have purified water for all participants
4. *What's the weather like?* In June it is generally sunny in the mornings, with a chance of afternoon rain, temperatures are mild and get cooler in the evenings - sweatshirt weather
5. *When do I have to pay the balance?* By March 31, 2020
6. *How far is the airport from where we'll be staying/going?* Approximately an hour
7. *Will I get a chance to purchase any local souvenirs/go to a market?* Yes
8. *Do I need any immunizations before traveling?* None that we require, but do check with your healthcare provider
9. *What is appropriate dress? Can I wear shorts/dresses above the knee? Can I wear tank top/sleeveless dress?* Most appropriate is to wear long shorts and pants, tank top and sleeveless is appropriate for work and hotter temperatures
10. *What time do I need to arrive by?* Try to arrive on ...
11. *How will I get from the airport to where I need to go?* Our team will handle all your transport upon your arrival until you depart
12. *Can you accommodate my dietary needs?* Yes, please let us know ahead of time
13. *What will younger kids be doing?\** Kids will have age appropriate activities and projects. We will include kids and our service will be together as a group both at camp and in the communities. \*However, minimum age recommendation is 9.
14. *What will we be doing for work projects?* We are helping prepare the camp property to be a place kids can come and hear the gospel proclamation in an environment made just for them. When we are in the city communities we will be with Young Life leaders and teenagers and their families.
