Access from AT&T only \$10/month

Must submit proof that at least one person in your household is enrolled in one of these:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) in CA only
- National School Lunch Program | Head Start
- Household income is 135% or less than the federal poverty guidelines

Spectrum Internet Assist for \$17.99/month

Must submit proof that at least one person in your household is enrolled in one of these:

- National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
- Community Eligibility Provision of the NSLP
- Supplemental Security Income (age 65+ only)

SSN is not required for either application!
