[January 15, 2020] The Upland Unified School District has immediate openings for **two paid internship positions** in its Garden Program.

The District is looking for student candidates from the College of Environmental Design. Sponsored by longtime ENV supporter Randall Lewis, the internship relates to nutrition, growing food and Upland public schools. **Gardening experience is a must** to be considered for the position.

The intern will assist in the construction of a garden at assigned school sites. Duties include:

- Building of school gardens
- Maintenance of school gardens including but not limited to: weeding, installing and fixing irrigation, planting and harvesting
- The planting, harvesting and processing of garden crops and coordination of use of garden produce in cafeteria lunches

Ideal candidates are expected to demonstrate excellent communication skills, independent thinking and must be a self-starter. They must also have access to a personal vehicle, and be available to work 10 hours/week for 25 weeks.

The position pays \$15/hour for undergraduate students, and \$20/hour for graduate students.
