

Our sanctuary is equipped with a hearing loop. Those who wear hearing aids can have the T-coil activated by their audiologist enabling them to receive the audio signal directly in their hearing aids. Along with the hearing loop, assisted listening devices are available at the soundboard.

Preschool and elementary children during worship: Childcare is provided for infants through kindergarten age during all Sunday morning activities. Childcare is located on the second floor of the educational building. If you are unfamiliar with this service, an usher can direct you to the proper room.

First Grade through Fifth Grade children are invited to participate in First Kids Worship following the *Time with the Children*. The service is designed as an age-appropriate worship service for elementary age children and is held in the fellowship hall; parents will pick their children up in the fellowship hall. **Worship bags** are available at the rear of the sanctuary for all children.

Today's offertory is one of Bach's most unique preludes in organ literature. This piece was likely improvised during Bach's tenure as organist in Weimar. While this piece sounds good in our modern ears, it was considered daring, contemporary music in Bach's day. His use of *stylus fantasticus* (the fantastic style) and chromaticism would send many a person to the Duke of Weimar with complaints on the young Bach's improvisation. As with all of his works in which he penned as praise to God, the young Bach signed the piece *Soli Deo Gloria*, which translates "To God alone be the Glory!"
