

This piece is a setting of the hymn, "Open Now Thy Gates of Beauty". The text was originally set by Benjamin Schmolck (1672-1737), a German Lutheran writer of hymns. This setting for organ is by Paul Manz (1919-2009). Today's organ improvisation is based on Psalm 27:4, Isaiah 30:19, and Psalm 3:1.
