Easter Prayer Vigil: As we prepare to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ, we invite you to draw near to Him through an Easter Prayer Vigil. This vigil begins at 8:00 pm on Maundy Thursday (April 17th) and continues through noon on Good Friday (April 18th). To participate, simply sign up for a one-hour prayer slot at a time that works best for you. You are welcome to pray from home or, if your chosen hour falls within church hours, feel free to pray at church if you prefer—whatever feels most comfortable.
